Disposal Policy:

- 1. Call the Operator on duty using your cell phone (a) **978-744-4550 x116** or push the call box button located at the gate entrance of our facility. Turn off your engine so they can hear you.
- 2. Inform the Operator that you are either camping at Winter Island Park or a Salem, MA resident.
- 3. The gate will automatically open once your identity has been verified.
- 4. Follow the posted signs to the RV Holding Tank Disposal Station.
- 5. Open the combination padlock with the code supplied.
- 6. Open the RV access hatch and place your disposal hose into the hatch opening.
- 7. Connect the other end of the hose to your RV and proceed to dump your wastewater.
- 8. When finished, flush your hose out into the RV access hatch and clean up any spillage using the garden hose provided.

Do not allow any <u>RV wastewater</u> or <u>trash</u> to enter the catch basin located near the RV station. THIS BASIN IS FOR <u>STORM WATER ONLY</u> AND DRAINS <u>UNTREATED</u> INTO CAT COVE.

- 9. Return the hose to the rack and lock up the access hatch with the padlock.
- 10. Deposit your RV Wastewater Disposal Ticket into the ticket receiving box (Campers only; Salem Resident forms are completed by an Operator on duty).
- 11. When leaving the property, pull up close to the exit gate and it will automatically open.

Notes:

- → The RV Holding Tank Disposal Station is open for use by registered Winter Island Park Campers and Salem, MA residents only.
- → Storage tanks removed from an RV and transported in another vehicle WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO DISPOSE OF THEIR WASTE AT THE DISPOSAL STATION.

Failure to follow the District's policies will result in a loss of disposal privileges.
